

### PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE BEGINNING

\* All seams are sewn with 1/4" seam allowance.

\* Press seams toward each added piece.

\* RST = right sides together

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

### Cutting based on 42" wide fabric (WOF-Width of Fabric)

#### From Fabric A cut:

\* (10) 3" squares

#### From Fabric B cut:

\* (10) 3" x 10-1/2" pieces

\* (10) 3" x 8" pieces

\* (10) 3" x 5-1/2" pieces

\* (10) 3" squares

#### From Fabric C cut:

\* (10) 3" x 8" pieces

\* (10) 3" x 5-1/2" pieces

#### From Fabric D cut:

\* (10) 3" x 13" pieces

\* (10) 3" x 10-1/2" pieces

\* (7) 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding

#### From Fabric E cut:

\* (10) 3" squares

#### From Fabric F cut:

\* (10) 3" x 10-1/2" pieces

\* (10) 3" x 8" pieces

\* (10) 3" x 5-1/2" pieces

\* (10) 3" squares

#### From Fabric G cut:

\* (6) 4-1/2" x WOF strips

\* (10) 3" x 8" pieces

\* (10) 3" x 5-1/2" pieces

#### From Fabric H cut:

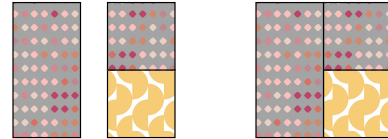
\* (10) 3" x 13" pieces

\* (10) 3" x 10-1/2" pieces

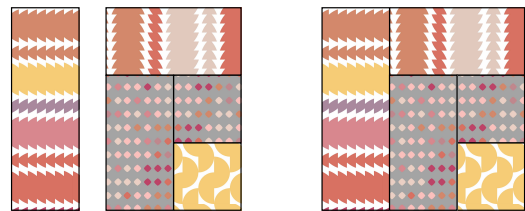
## BLOCK CONSTRUCTION

### Block #1

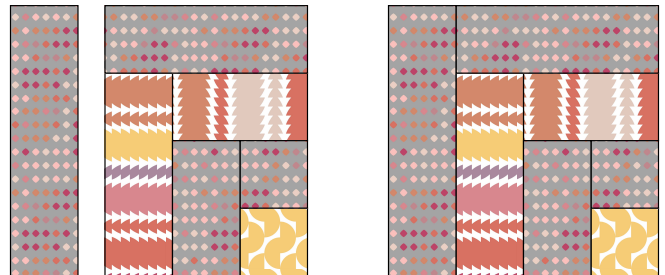
1. Sew one 3" B square to one 3" A square. Sew one 3" x 5-1/2" B piece to the left side.



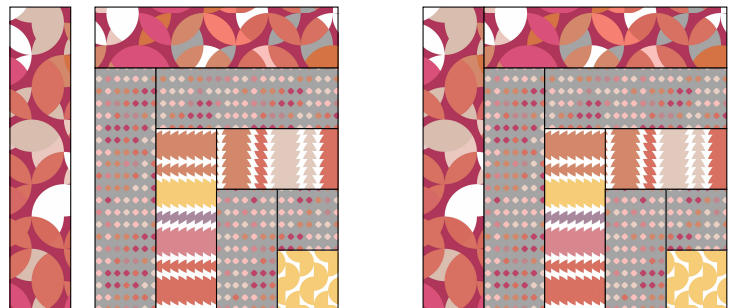
2. Sew one 3" x 5-1/2" C piece to the top of the unit from step 1. Sew one 3" x 8" C piece to the left side.



3. Sew one 3" x 8" B piece to the top of the unit from step 2. Sew one 3" x 10-1/2" B piece to the left side.



4. Sew one 3" x 10-1/2" D piece to the top of the unit from step 3. Sew one 3" x 13" D piece to the left side to make a 13" square block.



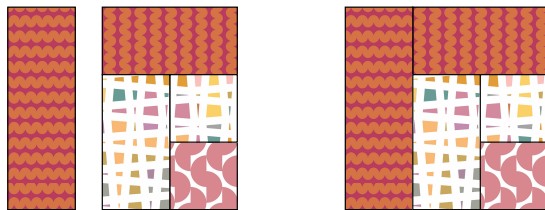
5. Repeat steps 1-4 to make a total of ten of block #1.

## Block #2

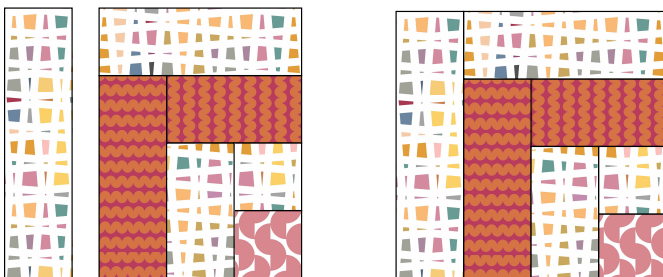
**6.** Sew one 3" E square to one 3" F square. Sew one 3" x 5-1/2" F piece to the left side.



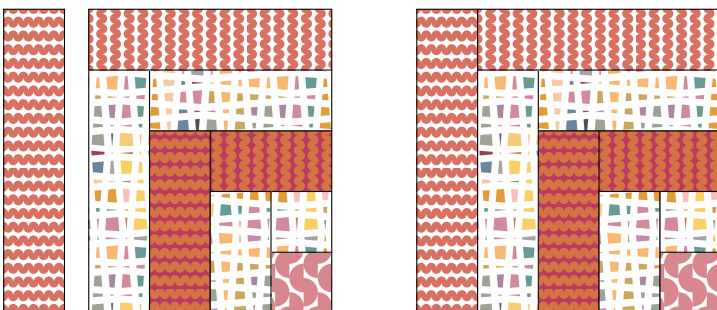
**7.** Sew one 3" x 5-1/2" G piece to the top of the unit from step 6. Sew one 3" x 8" G piece to the left side.



**8.** Sew one 3" x 8" F piece to the top of the unit from step 7. Sew one 3" x 10-1/2" F piece to the left side.



**9.** Sew one 3" x 10-1/2" H piece to the top of the unit from step 8. Sew one 3" x 13" H piece to the left side to make a 13" square block.



**10.** Repeat steps 6-9 to make a total of ten of block #2.

Follow the quilt layout diagram on the next page for sewing the blocks together.

**1.** Lay out the #1 and #2 blocks into (5) rows of (4) blocks each, noting orientation of the blocks. Sew the blocks into rows and join the rows to complete the quilt center.

**2.** Sew the six 4-1/2" x WOF G strips short ends together with diagonal seams. Press seams open.

**3.** Measure the quilt through the vertical center (top to bottom) of the quilt. Trim (2) strips to this length. Matching centers and ends, pin and sew to sides.

**4.** Measure the quilt through the horizontal center (side to side) of the quilt. Trim (2) strips to this length. Matching centers and ends, pin and sew to sides.

## FINISHING

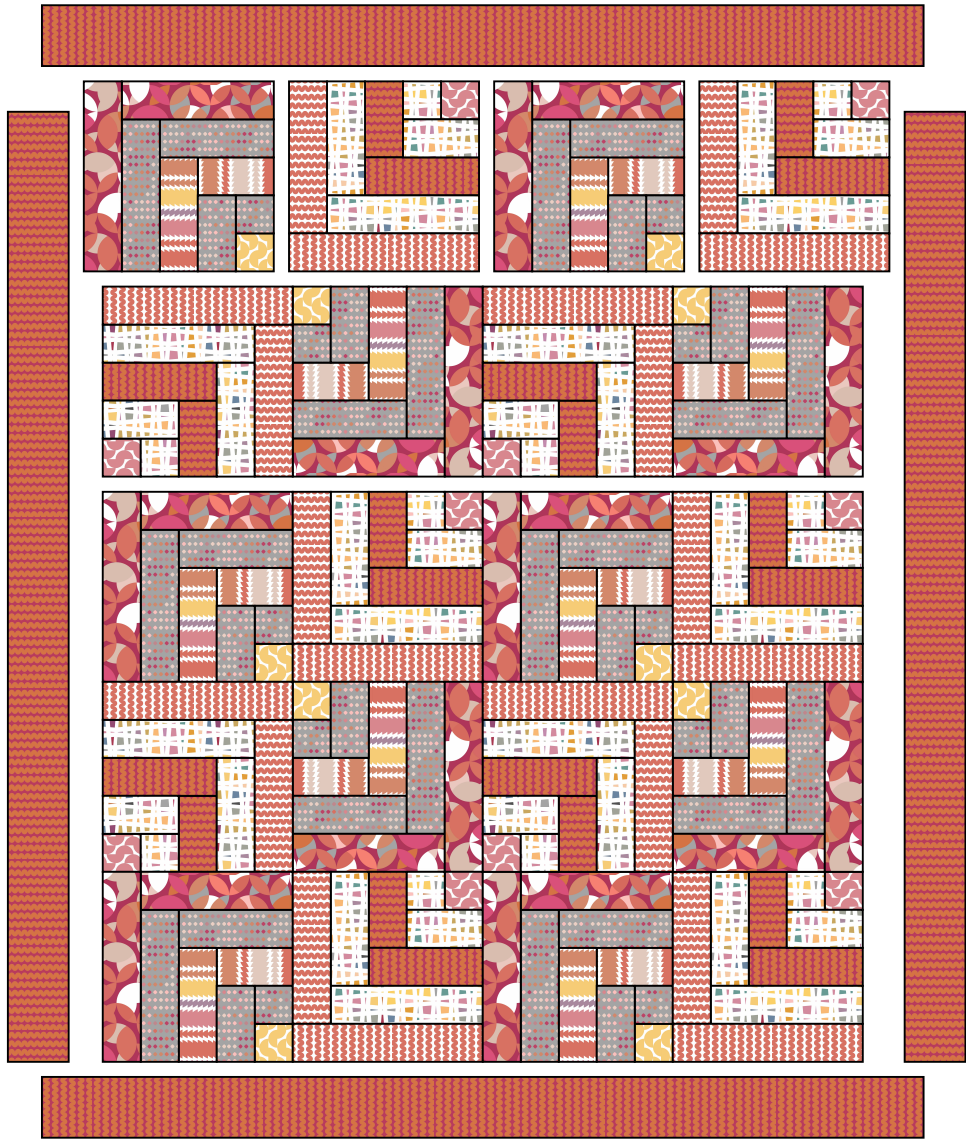
**1.** Cut backing fabric into (2) equal lengths and sew together to make the quilt back.

**2.** Layer top, batting and pieced backing. Baste if necessary and quilt as desired.

**3.** Sew the seven 2-1/2" x WOF D binding strips short ends together with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Fold in half length-wise wrong sides together and sew to quilt with a French binding technique. Fold binding to back and hand sew down.

***Be sure to put a label on the back and ENJOY!***
