

**PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS  
BEFORE BEGINNING**

- \* All seams are sewn with 1/4" seam allowance.
- \* Press seams toward each added piece.
- \* RST = right sides together

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

### ***Cutting based on 42" wide fabric (WOF-Width of Fabric)***

#### ***From each of Fabrics A-D cut:***

- \* (1) 14" x 20" rectangle for backing***
- \* (1) 6-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangle***

#### ***From each of Fabrics E-H cut:***

- \* (4) 2-1/2" x 9" rectangles***
- \* (4) 2-1/2" x 4" rectangles***

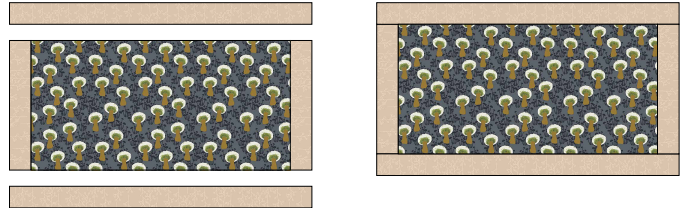
***Note: For directional prints, cut (1) 4" x WOF strip, and then cut (4) 2-1/2" x 4" rectangles***

#### ***From each of Fabrics I-L cut:***

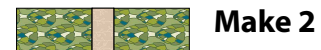
- \* (2) 2-1/4" x WOF strips for binding***
- \* (2) 1-1/2" x 14-1/2" rectangles***
- \* (2) 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles***
- \* (4) 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles***

## PLACEMAT CONSTRUCTION

**1.** Sew 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" I rectangles to opposite sides of one 6-1/2" x 12-1/2" B rectangle. Sew 1-1/2" x 14-1/2" I rectangles to the top and bottom to complete the placemat center.



**2.** Sew 2-1/2" x 4" E rectangles to opposite sides of one 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" I rectangle to make a side border. Make two. In the same way, sew 2-1/2" x 9" E rectangles to opposite sides of one 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" I rectangle to make a top/bottom border. Make two.

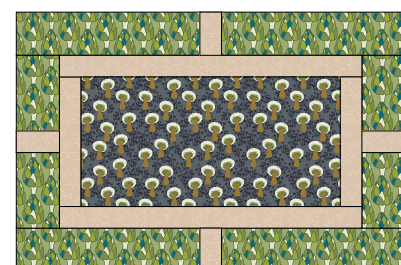
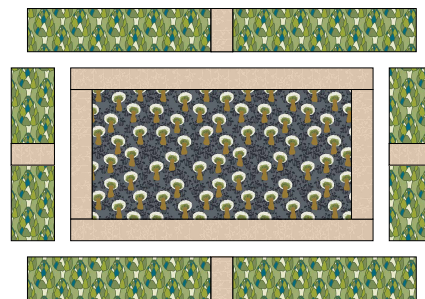

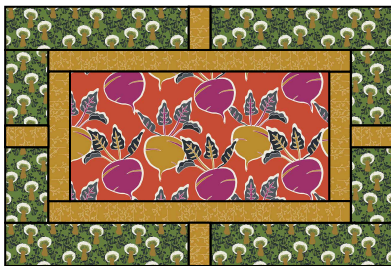
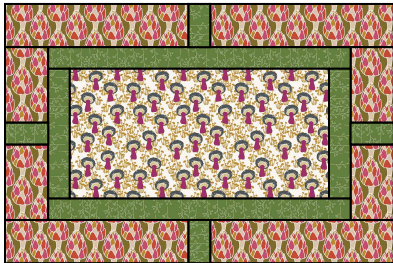
**3.** Sew side borders to opposite sides of the placemat center. Sew top/bottom borders to the top and bottom to complete the placemat top.

## PLACEMAT CONSTRUCTION

4. Repeat steps 1-3 to make a total of four placemat tops.



## FINISHING

1. Layer each placemat top, batting and coordinating backing rectangle that matches placemat center. Baste if necessary and quilt as desired.
2. For each placemat, sew the two matching 2-1/2" x WOF binding strips short ends together with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Fold in half lengthwise wrong sides together and sew to quilt with a French binding technique. Fold binding to back and hand sew down.

***Be sure to put a label on the back and ENJOY!***
