A  Doodle Frog Blue
RL4600-07
1/2 Yard


B  Flower Petals
Magenta
RL4610-32
1/2 Yard

C  Frog Fish White
RL4620-02
5/8 Yard

D  Heart Lily Pad
Orange
RL4630-10
3/8 Yard

E  Splash Green
RL4640-09
1-1/8 Yards

F  Splash Magenta
RL4640-32
1/4 Yard

G  Rainbow Stripe
Green
RL4650-09
3/4 Yard

Backing: 3 Yards Batting: 54" x 67"

**PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS
BEFORE BEGINNING**

- * All seams are sewn with 1/4" seam allowance.
- * Press seams toward each added piece.
- * RST = right sides together

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Cutting based on 42" wide fabric (WOF-Width of Fabric)

From Fabric A cut:

*** (4) 3-1/2" x WOF strips**

From Fabric B cut:

*** (2) 5-1/2" x WOF strips**

From Fabric C cut:

*** (3) 5-1/2" x WOF strips**

From Fabric D cut:

*** (4) 2-1/2" x WOF strips**

From Fabric E cut:

*** (6) 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding**

*** (9) 1-1/2" x WOF strips**

From Fabric F cut:

*** (4) 1-1/2" x WOF strips**

From Fabric G cut:

*** (6) 3-1/2" x WOF strips**

2. Sew 1-1/2" x WOF E strips lengthwise to opposite sides of (1) 5-1/2" x WOF B strip. Make (2) B-E strips.



3. Referring to the Quilt Assembly Diagram on p. 3, lay out (3) 5-1/2" x WOF C strips, (4) 1-1/2" x WOF F strips, (4) A-D units and (2) B-E units. Sew together lengthwise to make the quilt center.

4. Trim on long edges so quilt center measures 40-1/2" wide. Quilt center should measure 40-1/2" x 53-1/2".

5. Trim (2) 1-1/2" x WOF E strips to measure 40-1/2". Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Sew the remaining (3) 1-1/2" x WOF E strips short ends together into a long strip. Measure the quilt through the vertical center (top to bottom) and cut (2) strips to that length. Sew to opposite sides of the quilt center.

6. Sew (6) 3-1/2" x WOF G strips short ends together into one long strip. Measure the quilt through the vertical center and cut (2) strips to that length. Sew to opposite sides of the quilt center. Measure the quilt through the horizontal center (side to side) and cut (2) strips to that length. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt to complete the quilt top.

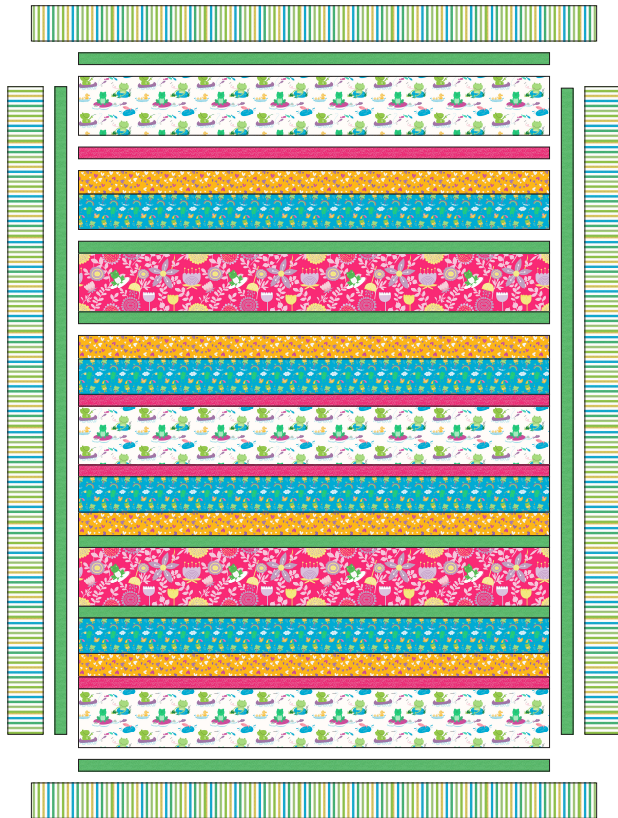
QUILT ASSEMBLY

Note: Pay attention to the orientation of directional fabric strips as you assemble the quilt.

1. Sew (1) 3-1/2" x WOF A strip lengthwise to (1) 2-1/2" x WOF D strip. Make (4) A-D units.



QUILT LAYOUT



FINISHING

1. Cut backing fabric into (2) equal lengths and sew together to make the quilt back.
2. Layer top, batting and pieced backing. Baste if necessary and quilt as desired.
3. Sew the (6) 2-1/2" x WOF E binding strips short ends together with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Fold in half lengthwise wrong sides together and sew to quilt with a French binding technique. Fold binding to back and hand sew down.

Be sure to put a label on the back and ENJOY!
