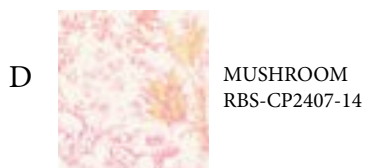

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

FEATURING the darling collection SWEET BABY by Cid Pear. We chose girly colors for a sweet pink Squared Up Play Mat, presented by Lisa Swenson Ruble. Please see Blue Version.



Quilt size: 39" x 39"

Block count & size: (12) 10" square

E	Hare RBS-CP2408-14	1/8 yard	Blocks
F	Chikadee RBS-CP2401-14	2/3 yard	Border

Backing: 1-1/4 yards

Batting: 45" square

## GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

**PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS  
BEFORE BEGINNING**

- All seams are sewn with 1/4" seam allowance.
- Press in the direction of the arrows unless instructed otherwise.

# SQUARED UP PLAY MAT

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

### Cutting

Based on 42" wide fabric  
(WOF-Width of Fabric)

From Fabric A:  
(9) 6-1/2" squares, fussy-cut to center kissing bunnies

From Fabric B:  
(20) 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" pieces  
(5) 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding

From Fabric C:  
(16) 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" pieces

From Fabric D:  
(20) 2-1/2" squares

From Fabric E:  
(16) 2-1/2" squares

From Fabric F:  
(4) 5" x WOF strips



## BLOCK CONSTRUCTION

Making the Blocks

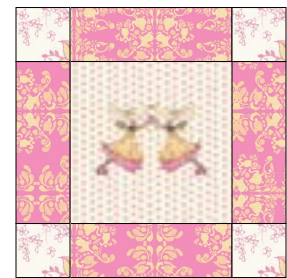
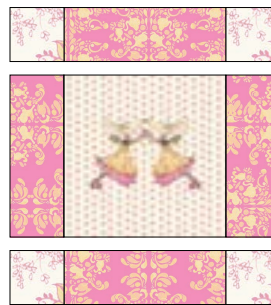
### B/D Blocks

1. Sew 2-1/2" D squares to opposite ends of (1) 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" B piece. Make two.



2. Sew 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" B pieces to opposite sides of (1) 6-1/2" A square. Sew to the top and bottom of the center unit. Make a total of (5) B-D blocks.

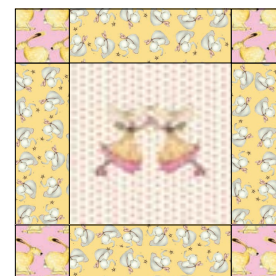

### C/E Blocks

3. Sew 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" C pieces to opposite sides of (1) 6-1/2" A square. Sew 2-1/2" E squares to opposite ends of (1) 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" C piece. Make two. Sew to the top and bottom of the center unit. Make a total of (4) C-E blocks.

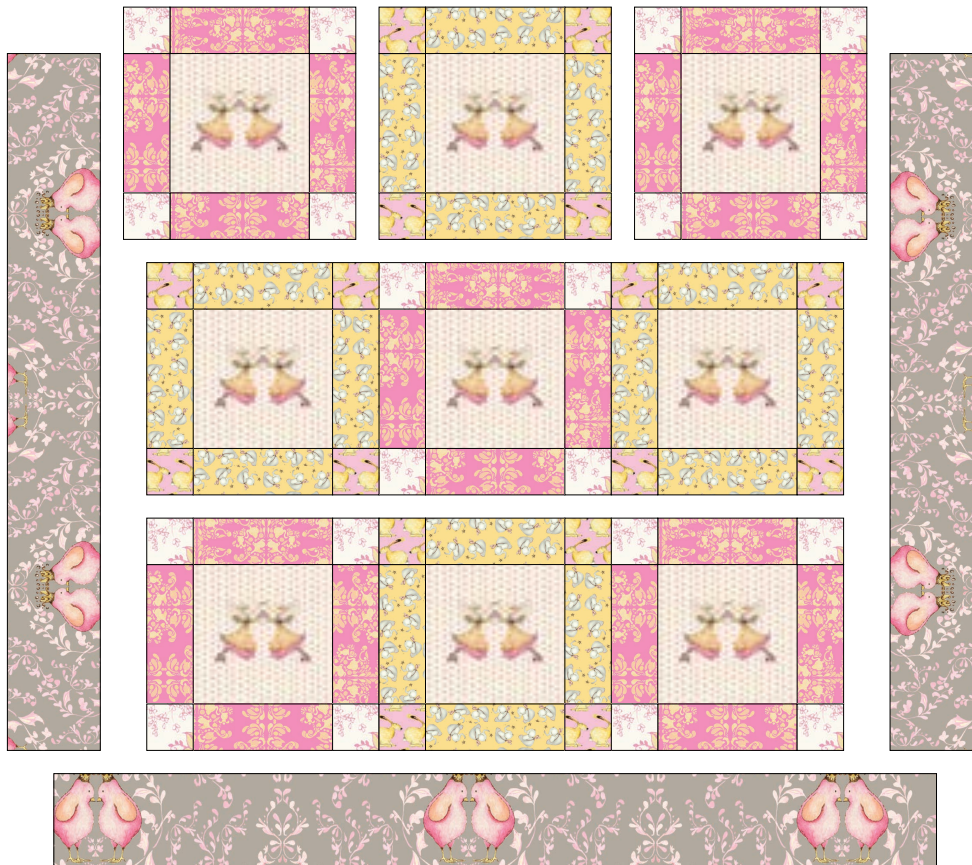

# QUILT CONSTRUCTION

## QUILT Assembly

### *Sew Right Sides Together*

1. Lay out the (5) B/D blocks and (4) C/E blocks into (3) rows of (3) blocks each. Sew the blocks into rows and join the rows to complete the quilt center.
2. Measure the quilt lengthwise. Trim (2) 5" x WOF F strips to that length and sew to opposite sides of the quilt center. Measure the quilt width-wise, including the borders just added. Trim (2) 5" x WOF F strips to that length and sew to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top.

### Finishing the Quilt

1. Layer quilt top, batting and backing and quilt as desired.







## QUILT Binding

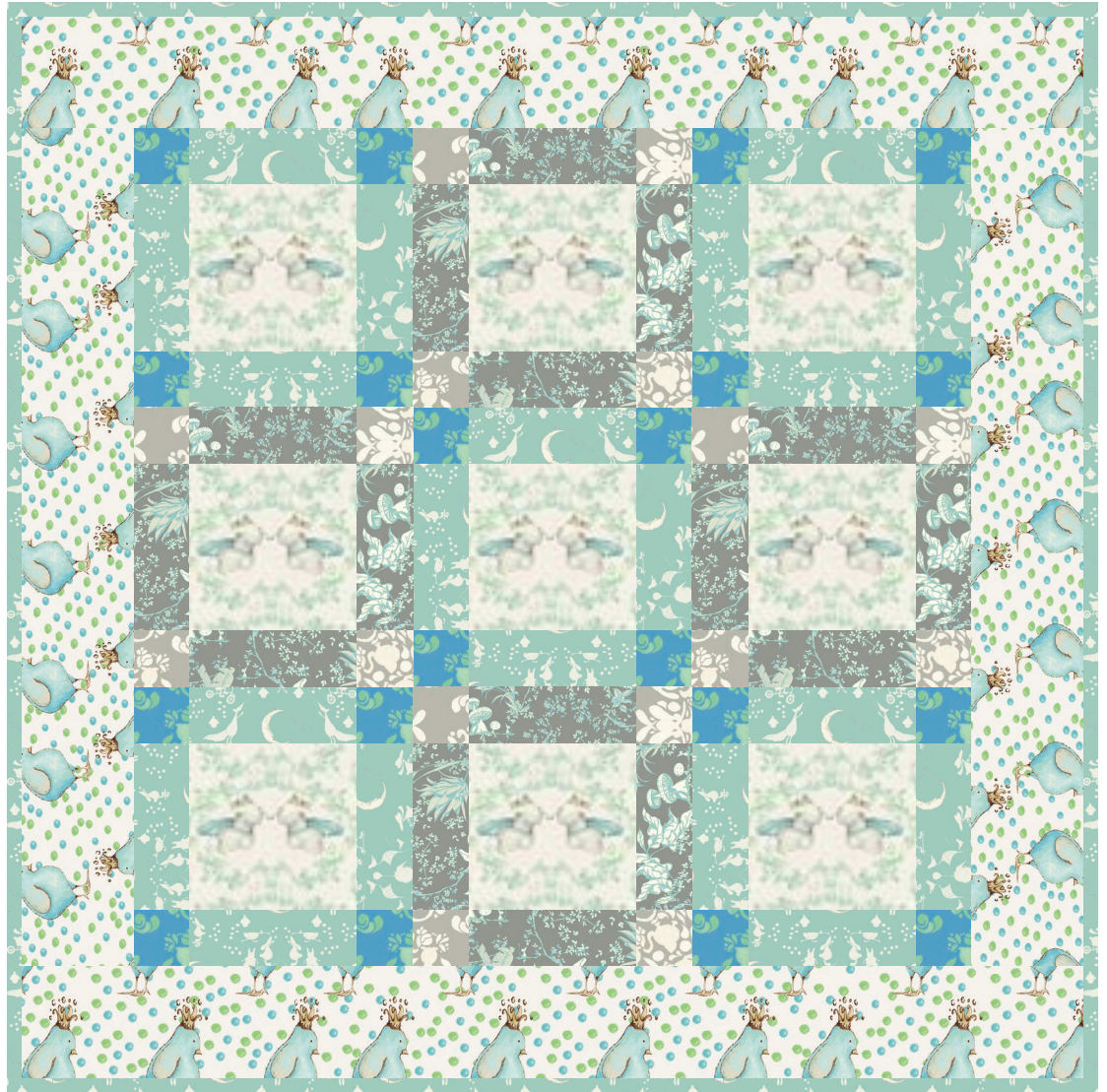
- Piece (5) 2-1/2" X WOF strips together at the short ends. Start sewing the binding strip in the middle of one of the sides of the quilt. Place the strip right sides of the quilt, placing the strip right side down and leaving approximately a 5" tail.
- Sew with 1/4" seam allowance (using a straight stitch) aligning the strip's raw edge with the quilt top's raw edge. Stitch around the quilt.
- Stop stitching before you reach the last 5-6".
- Lay the loose ends of the binding flat along the quilt edge, folding the ends back on themselves to form a crease where they meet. Stitch along this crease to join the ends.
- Complete sewing the binding onto the quilt edge.
- Turn the binding to the back of the quilt, turn the raw edge inside and stitch by hand using a blind stitch.

## Fabric Requirements

- A - 1 yard Flying Elephant, RBS-CP2404-3
- B - 7/8 yards Celebrations, RBS-CP2411-17
- C - 1/3 yard Mushroom, RBS-CP2407-4
- D - 1/4 yard Baby Brocade, RBS-CP2409-12
- E - 1/8 yard Baby Brocade, RBS-CP2409-31
- F - 2/3 yard Blue Chick, RBS-CP2405-7
- 1-1/4 yards backing fabric
- 45" square of batting



While careful proofing to ensure the accuracy of this pattern has been undertaken, we can not be responsible for printing errors or inaccurate piecing. This is due to variances in which individuals work. Please be sure to read all instructions carefully before starting to cut and construct this project.

*Remember to wash and press your fabrics prior to cutting.*
